THE CHIVALRIC ORDER OF KNIGHT MASONS



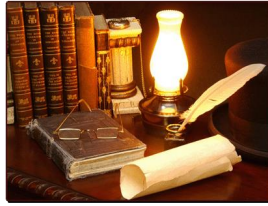
